ATTORNEY’S REPORT

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EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT

Executive Director Vasilevski reported that the Beds Plus event took place and that Commissioner Keefer was able to attend. Commissioner Keefer noted that the event was well attended and that she enjoyed it.

Executive Director Vasilevski also informed the Board that the Commission’s website must comply with the Illinois Information Technology Accessibility Act as well as federal ADA requirements to ensure accessible, navigable, and perceivable digital content for users with disabilities.

Executive Director Vasilevski shared that he is looking into the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) program, which provides de-escalation and scenario-based training for local police departments and agencies. Commissioner Gilhooley expressed interest in attending a session in the future.

Executive Director Vasilevski further reported that he is exploring the option of hiring a company to assist in developing a three- to five-year Strategic Plan for the Commission. He explained that such firms typically conduct surveys with villages and agencies to identify service gaps and community needs.

Executive Director Vasilevski noted that a legislative update has been included in the Board book for Commissioners to review.

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
ADJOURNMENT
